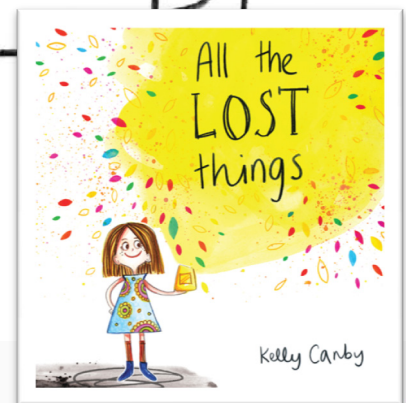
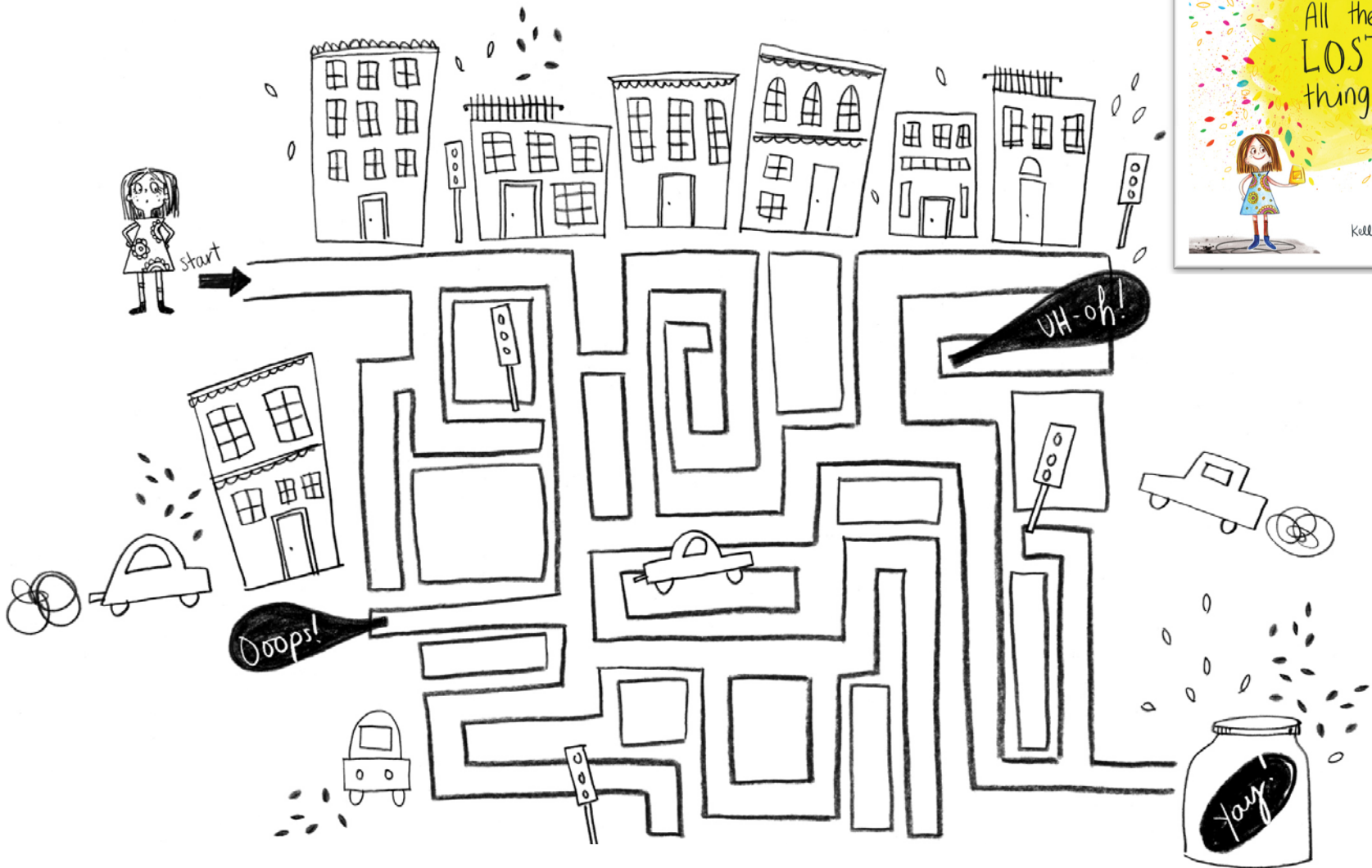


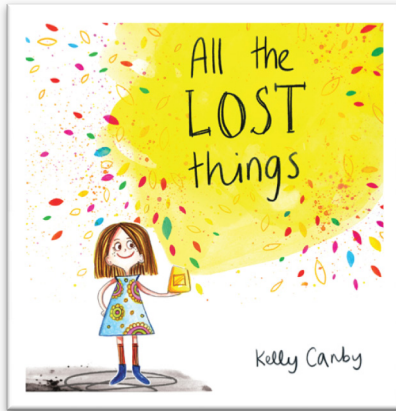
In the book *All the Lost Things*, Olive brings color to her whole town!
